FUND RAISING ZONES

Introduction

1. Periodically questions are raised by sub-branches regarding areas that are available to them for fund raising.
2. This AI provides advice regarding the common courtesy required when dealing with other sub-branches and in particular when arranging fund raising or any other activity within recognised sub-branch zones.

Detail

3. There are no formally defined zones within South Australia, but the accepted practice is that an area is the responsibility of the nearest sub-branch and any VVAA activity undertaken within that area should be cleared with the nearest sub-branch, as it would be considered within their zone.
4. Sub-branches that have no specific area of responsibility, for example a Sub-Branch, can select any area within the State for fund raising activities on the condition that agreement is obtained from the sub-branch responsible for that particular zone.
5. All that is required by a sub-branch or an individual wishing to conduct an activity is to contact the local Sub-Branch President or Secretary and obtain their agreement. Selling raffle tickets or tin rattling in other sub-branch areas could cause ill feeling between veteran groups and most certainly could cause confusion within the local community.
6. It is highly recommended that the common courtesy of advising other sub-branches of your intended activities within their area of responsibility should be adopted by all members of the VVAA. Sub-branches should advise their members accordingly.
